in the classroom according to the most recent study commissioned by PBS. Librarians and booksellers report that books featured on the program receive enormous requests and quickly become "classics" in kids' personal libraries.

READING RAINBOW's dynamic, fast-paced, magazine-style format -

features on location, real life settings, colorful animation, hip music videos, and lots of singing and dancing. Popular personalities, including books, while captivating illustrations appear on-screen. Capsule reviews presented by real kids expand on the themes in the feature book, while "Kid-on-thestreet" interviews allow real kids to sound off about issues in each episode.
