★ Instead of invading other countries in the guise of combatting stateless terrorism, Ralph Nader would rely on more effective intelligence, policing and prosecution—**without abusing basic human rights**. He would rethink American policies that go to the roots of such violence, such as U.S. support of dictatorial regimes that brutalize their people.



★ Nader's proposals would be funded by a fair tax system that eliminates loopholes and ensures that corporations pay their share. Nader would **relieve the tax burden on working families**. For example:

- Nader would eliminate federal income taxes on the first \$50,000 of personal income.
- Nader would place a penny tax on every stock market trade. This would generate \$150 billion for the federal government.
