Camilo Mejia is the courageous young man who served six years in the military before being deployed to Iraq and then realized he had to follow his conscience, come home, and say no to war as a conscientious objector. He was found guilty of desertion and is serving a one year prison sentence.

The route begins at The Peace Abbey in Sherborn (See directions on the other side) and includes rest stops along the way. Final destination is Hanscom Air Force Base in Bedford where Camilo surrendered to military authorities as a conscientious objector. Water, healthy snacks and bathroom facilities available along the route.
