The Hayden Concertinas play the same tone on both press & draw of the Bellows. Low Notes are on the left hand, and high notes on the right hand. The scales in many Keys \*\* are arranged in the same manner, with alternate runs of 3 (Do, Re, Mi.) and 4 (Fa, So, La, Ti.) consecutive buttons, The next octave then starting again (above the 1st Do). Chords are particularly simple to play, each chord type (such as Major, Minor, Dominant 7th etc.) has it's own simple fingering pattern which is the same for most chords of that type, and are in exactly the same order as the Stradella System, but concertinered into half the width, [\* 6 Keys on the 46 button instruments and no less than 9!! on the 67 Button instrument - (Ab, Eb, Bb,) F, C, G, D, A, & E.) Both instruments may however be played in any Key, 2 more Keys with slightly modified fingering; and the other Key(s) somewhat differently.]
